0	Normal operations.
1	Take preventive measures. Attend lectures and seminars as well as experiments and practical training. Actively utilize online classes.
2	Shift face-to-face lectures and seminars to online. Take preventive measures. Conduct experiments and practical training.
3	Online classes only. Experiments and practical training are allowed with limits on the number of students.
4	Online classes only.

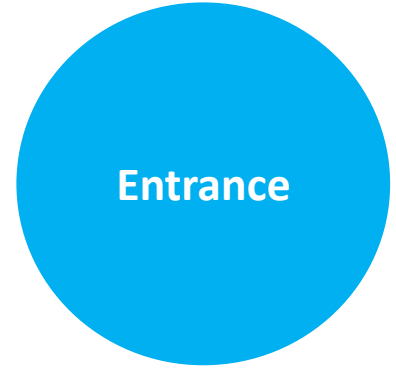

Entrance Restrictions :

Level 3 ⇒ 2

レベル	
0	No restrictions.
1	Undergrads: Avoid coming to campus except to attend classes. ★Make your stay on campus as short as possible.
2	Undergrads: Prohibited from coming to campus except to do experiments and practical training. Grads: Avoid coming to campus as much as possible.
3	All students are prohibited from coming to campus. ★Exception: grad students engaged in ongoing experiments and research activities.
4	All students are prohibited from coming to campus without exceptions.



Undergrads are allowed enter to campus to:

- 1) work on experiments or practical training
- 2) use libraries for a graduation thesis/research
- 3) access to campus WiFi
